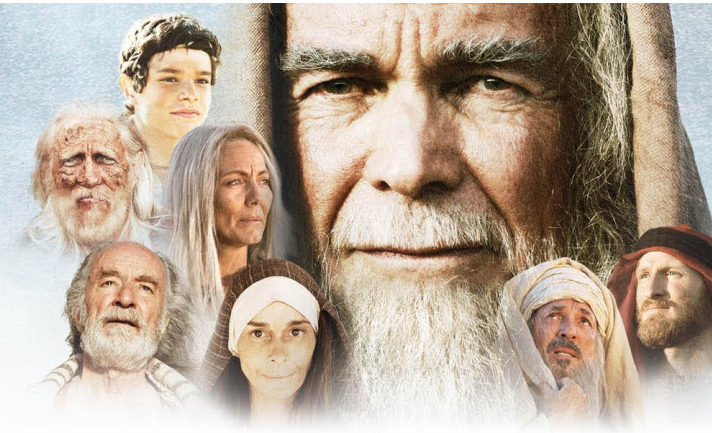

What Is Your Sacrifice?

Romans 12:1 says, *“I appeal to you therefore, brothers, by the mercies of God, to present your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and acceptable to God, which is your spiritual worship.”*

Do you think that God would want us to worship Him by offering a sacrifice? What are some things that our family could sacrifice?

Examples: Perhaps Mom has chosen to leave a career to care for your family. Or, maybe Dad works in full-time ministry serving other people. Maybe you (and your brothers and sisters) are being asked to give up something to help another family in need. Whatever it is, your sacrifice matters to God.

God asks each of His children to give Him one very special thing—their hearts.

Suggestion: After your discussion of the film, schedule a time of “family worship” where family members have the opportunity to dedicate themselves—and any other sacrifices—to the Lord.
