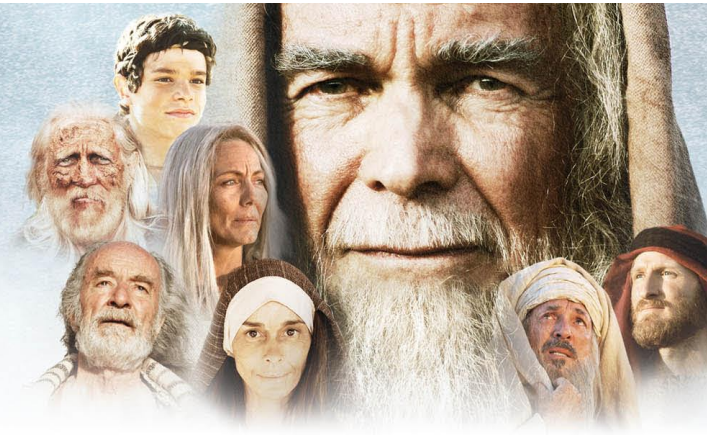

Gifts of Kindness

As God's people, we've been given the greatest gift of all—His Son, Jesus Christ. God has also promised to provide for all of our needs. Christians have no reason to ever be envious or greedy.

Lot might have taken the dry land, as a kindness to Abram, the uncle who took him in when he was left on his own. Instead, Lot chose the best lands for himself. God used Lot's choice to teach a lesson about the blessings of caring more for others than ourselves.

Ask each member of the family to give up something of value—perhaps a prized possession, or the gift of time or work. For example, you could do a favor for a friend or a chore for an elderly neighbor. The decision to participate should be entirely voluntary. You'll discover that few of us ever regret showing love and kindness to others.
