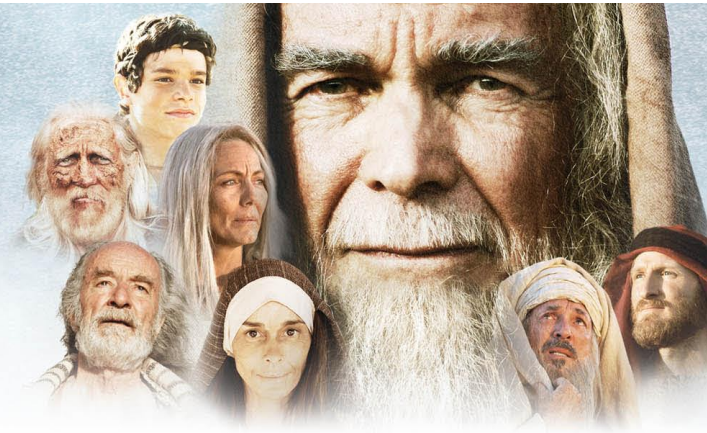

ADDITIONAL DISCUSS QUESTIONS

1. Do you ever wish that you were very rich?

3. What did Jesus do so that people can go to heaven?

ADDITIONAL ENGAGE ACTIVITY

God wants us to use what we have to help others, especially those in need. The rich man did not do that. He actually treated his pets better than Lazarus.

What about your family? Does your family help people the way God wants you to? If your family would like to do a better job of helping others, please pray and tell God.

Ask Him to show your family someone like Lazarus that you can help. He will. It may be someone in your neighborhood, at school, or even at church. God may want you to give that person something or to do something for them. God will bless you for giving (Acts 20:35).

Suggestion for Parents

Plan a special dinner when you can discuss with your children people in their lives that need help. Ask your children to think about their neighbors, teachers, and people at church – especially any widows or single moms. Challenge them to think about ways your family could practically help those in need that God brings to mind. If they want to give them something, ask them what they would be willing to sacrifice in order to do that (such as cutting off cable for a year to help pay someone's electric bill). If they want to perform an act of service, ask them what they want to do (cleaning their house, yard work, etc.) and get a commitment from them to do it on a specific date.
