Internal Revenue Service provides recorded tax information through a service called Tele-Tax. By following the directions on the recorded message, you can find some help with tax questions, including what to do when you cannot pay your taxes. The number to call for this help is (800) 829-4477. The Web site, www.irs.gov, also has helpful tax information.

Another resource that is available for those who are seeking to negotiate with the IRS about delinquent taxes is a book entitled How to Get Tax Amnesty, written by Dan Pilla. Although the title is somewhat misleading, this book gives helpful information about the options available to you if you owe taxes to the IRS.
